### Enquiry 1:

**Humanist:** possible to live a good and fulfilling life without following a traditional religion.

**Christian:** the belief that Jesus was the son of God

**Atheism:** an absence of belief in the existence of deities.

**Agnostic:** the view that the existence of God, is not certainly known.

**Theism:** belief in the existence of a god or gods, specifically of a creator who intervenes in the universe.

### Enquiry 4:

**Sacrifice:** the act of giving something precious to another person or God.

**Atonement:** a person atones when they show they are sorry for doing something wrong.

**Resurrection:** the Christian belief that Jesus rose from the dead on the third day after the crucifixion.

**Redemption:** atonement for sins; the idea of being saved from sin or evil.

### Enquiry 2:

**Hadith:** the sayings, actions, and approvals of Prophet Muhammad.

**Iconoclasm:** the rejection of religious beliefs.

**Mosque:** the Islamic place of worship.

**Prophet:** the one who speaks on behalf of a god.

**Philosophy**- the study of some of the most basic questions about human life

**Theology**- the study of one or more religions

**Human/Social Science** - the study of society and the manner in which people behave and influence the world around us



### Enquiry 5:

**Brahma:** the first God of the Trimurti.

**Dharma:** the duties a Hindu should follow in their life.

**Moksha:** the ultimate goal within Hinduism, to leave this cycle of rebirth

**Mandir:** where Hindus go to pray.
