

Payment and Delivery

Vouchers can take up to 14 working days to be sent out by Royal Mail 1st Class recorded postage, if you want a guaranteed turn around we can arrange collection for you just let your account handler know. We cannot guarantee delivery dates, as we use a third party organisation for postage. Upon request, we can provide a tracking number once the parcel has been processed by the delivery service.

If paying by cheque, the funds must be cleared before vouchers are issued, this will be a 10-working day clearing period. Vouchers cannot be issued until this period has passed.

Payment made via credit or debit card can be performed on site, or via a secure Payment Link we can provide. This is a remote immediate payment method. **Refunds are not available.**
