English

- This term our English lessons will be linked around picture books to engage the children. Our first topic will be based on the story book 'The Train Ride'.
- Key skills to help them improve their writing will be taught, including how to form letters, reducing letter size and how to use capital letters and full stops.
- We will also be looking at techniques to order events within books we have read and to write sentences about these stories.

Maths

- We will focus on basic skills including counting forwards and backwards to 100, number bonds to 10 including related subtraction and finding half of numbers and shapes.
- During our shape and measure topic we will be recognising and naming common 2D shapes.
- We will learn to count and recall in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and to double and halve numbers to 20.

DT/Art

- In Art children will experiment with tone and using colour to indicate mood in the style of the artist Pablo Picasso.
- In DT children will be making Christmas cards with moving parts involving mechanisms.

Science

During this term, children will be looking at the topic Animals including Humans.

Children will identify body parts of animals and classify and categorise animals in different ways.

- Hear your child read and record this in their home reading diary.

- Test them on their YRI spellings ready for their weekly spelling tests.
- Complete bi-weekly Pobble writing using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
