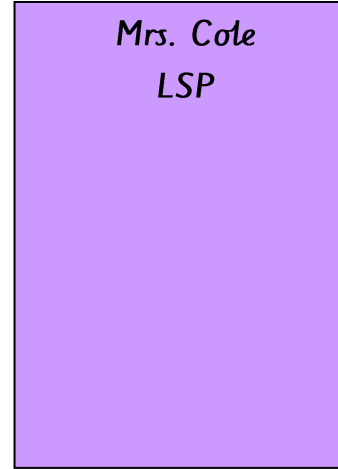

## English

In English this term we will be focusing on our class text - *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes. The children will produce a variety of text types including non-chronological reports, diary entries, character descriptions and poetry. The foci for writing this term will be using fronted adverbials and a range of punctuation marks accurately. We will also be conducting weekly handwriting, SPaG and Forensic Reading lessons throughout the term.

## Maths

This term in Maths we will be focussing on the place value of numbers up to 10,000, measuring the area of a shape, and enhancing our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be practicing our multiplication facts up to 12x12 daily during our fluency sessions. To help children to prepare for their multiplication check in the Summer term, we will be using Times Tables Rock Stars, which they can access outside of school using their logins.

## DT/Art

Our DT project this term will be to research, plan and bake biscuits. In order to do this, we will evaluate existing food products in terms of taste, smell, texture and appearance.

In Art we will be creating a landscape painting. We will compare the work of various landscape artists and use them to inspire our own pieces.

## What can you do at home to help?

- Encourage your child to complete their weekly Maths/Pobble task.

## Humanities

During this term the children will be looking at the Anglo-Saxons and their impact on Britain. We will look at:

- The reason for Romans leaving Britain.
- Who the Anglo-Saxons were and the groups of people that formed this community
- Identifying where and why the Anglo-Saxons chose to settle in Britain.
- How the Anglo-Saxons religion changed throughout their time period
- The Anglo-Saxon burial site - Sutton Hoo.

In the second half of the term, the children will be looking at the world's rainforests. We will explore different biomes, layers of the rainforests and also understand the lives of indigenous tribes who live within them.

## Science

In Autumn 1, we are looking at states of matter and living things and their habitats. We will be exploring solids, liquids and gases as well as looking at the water cycle.

In the second half-term, we will be learning about animals, where they live and also any environmental issues that may endanger them.
