### Maths

Nursery will dive into early maths through magical fairy tales! Children will subitise to 3 and count using Jack's beans, explore size and capacity with The

Three Bears, and become shape detectives while building for The Three Billy Goats Gruff. They'll also compare weight and length, building confidence in mathematical language through fun, hands-on adventures.



### English

This term, we will bring stories to life as children explore characters, events, and story structure. Children will retell familiar tales, sequence events, and create simple maps to help characters find their way home. They will also develop fine motor skills through fun, hands-on activities, including creative name writing with natural materials.



### Understanding the World

Children will become young investigators as they test which materials float or sink while building a raft for The Gingerbread Man. They'll also enjoy exciting stories of different cultures and explore maps to discover places around the world.





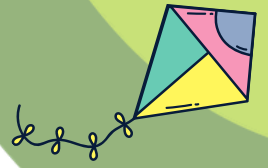
