### Maths

We will be developing number fluency, this involves looking at numbers up to 20, counting verbally and understanding the composition of these numbers. We will also be looking at 3D and 2D shapes. Further to this, we will be looking at grouping and sharing objects and developing an understanding of addition and subtraction.

### English


We will be using a wide range of high quality stories to help develop a love of reading, exposing the children to an extensive range of vocabulary. Children will be learning about beach safety, animals who live in the sea and how to be safe in the sun. Children will be using their phonetic knowledge to independently write full sentences.



### Understanding the World

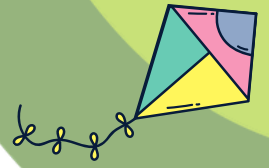
