Maths

We're excited to continue our weekly Maths for Life session. This term our topics will be Position and Direction and Statistics. During our Maths lessons, we will be deepening our understanding of Measures, including length, weight, mass, capacity and temperature. We will also consolidate the unit of Time.

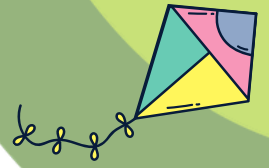
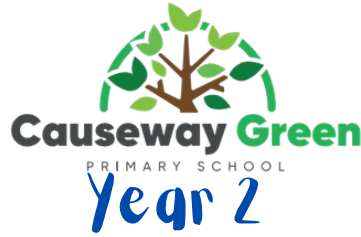


Science

In Geography, we will be learning all about Coasts. We will develop our understanding of the world's continents and oceans while revisiting countries and cities of the UK and the surrounding seas.

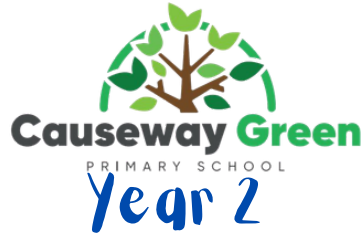


Computing

Art

Music

Pupils will also be introduced to dynamics and tempo. Children will create simple rhythm patterns and explore how music can express different moods and emotions.
