Maths

We will be continuing our Money topic, then moving on to Shape, Measure (mass/capacity/length), Time and Statistics. We will also be continuing with our weekly Maths 4 Life lessons. Continuing with the daily Maths Fluency programme 5 times tables and consolidation.



English

We will be using a video prompt 'Marshmallows' from the Literacy Shed and 'Roman Diary - Journal of Iliona' as inspiration for our writing. These texts will be used to write short narratives, balanced arguments and advertisements.

In reading, we will be summarising, inferring and retrieving information from a range of texts.




Science

Year 3 will be learning about plants, we will do this by investigating what plants need to grow, naming the different parts of a flower, exploring their functions and identifying how seeds are dispersed. Children will also be investigating how water is transported through plants and will research what plants need to grow and survive through experimentation.

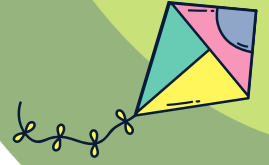
