

## CURRICULUM Spring Term – Year 6

### English

#### Writing

**Fiction: Stories on a theme - Difference** plan, draft, evaluate and edit writing, writing from a different perspective.

**Non-Fiction: Reports - Survivors** compose and write a recount of a real-life event

**Reading** 'Survivors: Extraordinary Tales from the Wild & Beyond' by David Long, Discussing vocabulary choices, tense and 3<sup>rd</sup> person perspective. 'Survivor Titanic' by Stephen Davies.

**SPAG** expanded noun phrases; relative clauses, cohesion between and within paragraphs, using punctuation to avoid ambiguity

### Maths

**Decimals & Fractions:** Percentages and fractions of amounts, multiply and divide fractions, ratios, proportion and percentages, compare and order fractions, equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting decimals (to 1 or 2 places), understand decimals with three places

**Algebra:** generate and continue linear sequences, generate and use simple formulae, solve equations with two unknowns

**Measure:** areas of a triangle, parallelogram, square and rectangle, perimeter of rectilinear shapes

**Place Value:** Negative numbers

**Living Things & Habitats:** look at lifecycles of insects, amphibians, flowering and non-flowering plants, birds and mammals, identify the differences in life cycles, life process of reproduction in some plants & animals, classification keys, Linnean classification, identifying groups in a class and similarities of animals within a class
