

CURRICULUM Autumn Term – Year 5

English

Writing – Using the Roald Dahl novel, Danny the Champion of the World, we will create character descriptions, make inferences from the text, and edit and uplevel our work using interesting vocabulary choices.

Poetry – I am the Dreadful Menace. We will look at personification, metaphor and simile, and write our own poem using the dreadful menace construct.

Speaking and Listening - We will have whole class discussion and debates on the moral questions raised in Danny the champion of the world, and pupils will express their personal views aloud.

Reading – Use our class text to answer questions with reference to VIPERS – Focus on making predictions on what is to come in the story based upon what we have read.

Maths

Place Value - Solve number problems and practical contexts involving place value

Number & Calculations – Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits using formal written methods

Multiplication and Division – Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a 1-digit number (including remainders)

Fractions Decimals & Percentages - Recognise and use percentages (e.g. 50%, 25%, 10%)

Understand equivalence between fractions, decimals and percentages

Shape/Geometry - Identify and measure angles in degrees

Classify angles (acute, obtuse, reflex)

Use angle rules (angles around a point = 360°, straight line = 180°)

Science

Earth and Space: Learn about the planets in our solar system as well as movements of the sun and the moon. **Forces:** Understand how forces act upon us and other objects including gravity, resistances (air, water and

Relationships: Different types of relationships, marriage/civil partnership, online friendships v real friendships, healthy friendships. Strategies to cope with bullying, personal safety.
