

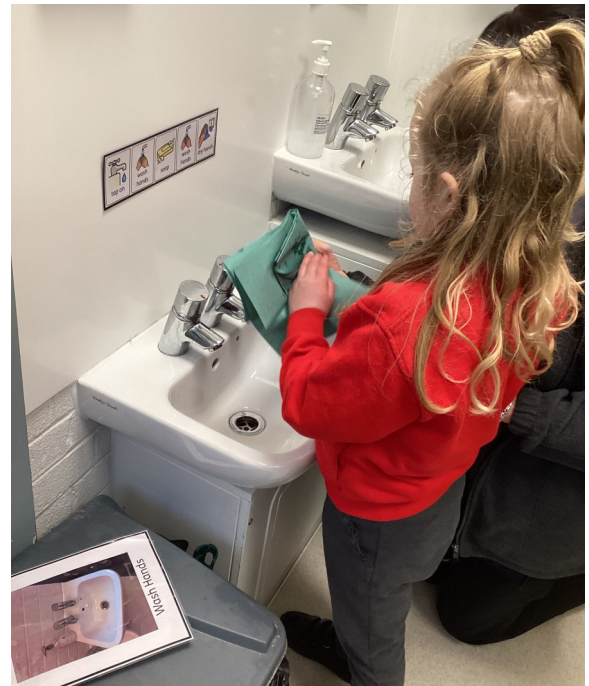
AMAZING!

This term it has been lovely to see our pupils' amazing achievements celebrated in the community

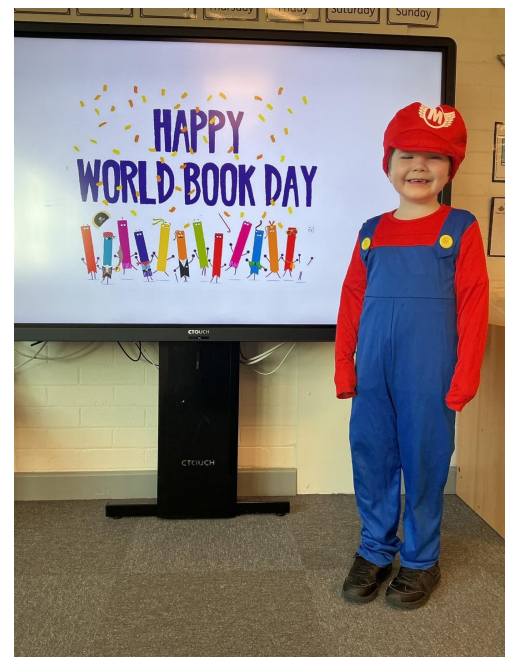


Performing at the Winter Gardens as part of the Wyre Celebration of Music Event.

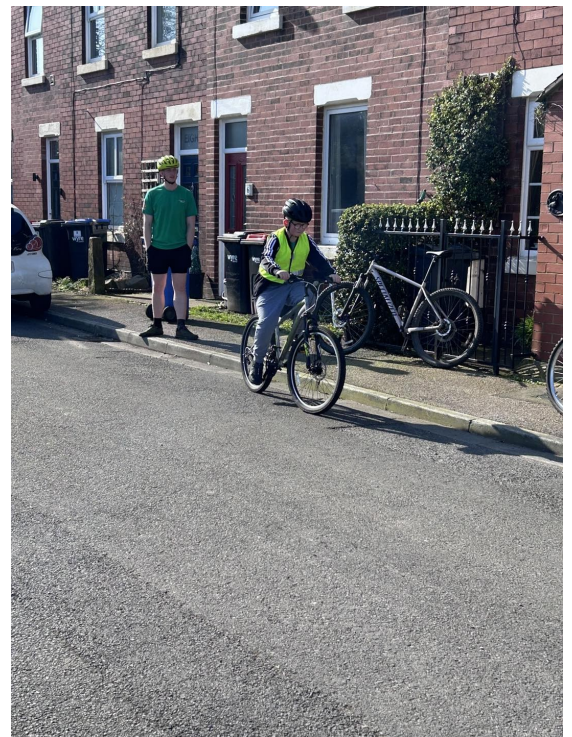


Performing with the Royal Shakespeare Company at the Grand Theatre.

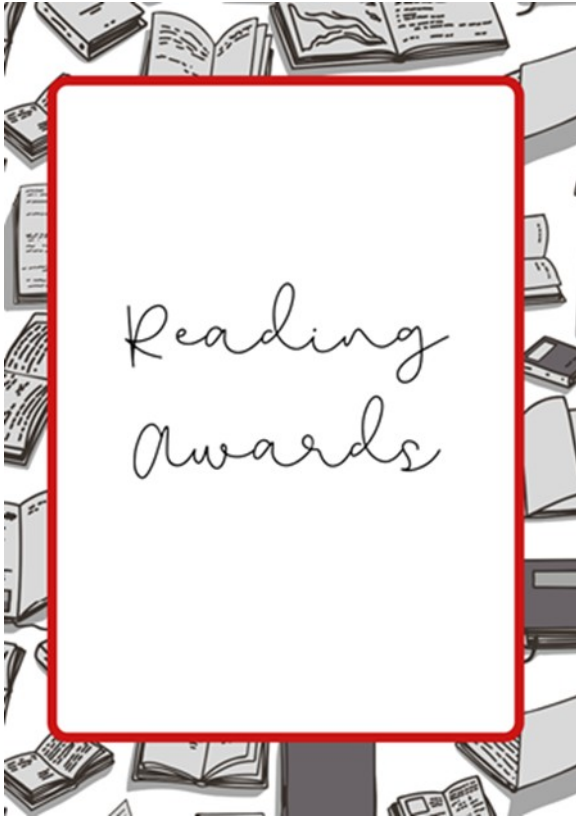
