## High Aspirations

As a 2–19 school, our exciting curriculum is split into three phases of learning: EYFS, Main School (Primary and Secondary), and Sixth Form. Each phase is broken down into Areas of Learning, within which there are sequenced knowledge and skills based Units of Work. These Units of Work ensure our curriculum is highly personalised and ambitious for all our pupils. Alongside these units, our Content Mapping ensures our pupils receive a broad, balanced, stimulating and engaging learning experience. We are delighted that Ofsted and our external advisors recognise our culture of aspiration across the school.

Communicating and cooperating with a partner to transport a log safely.

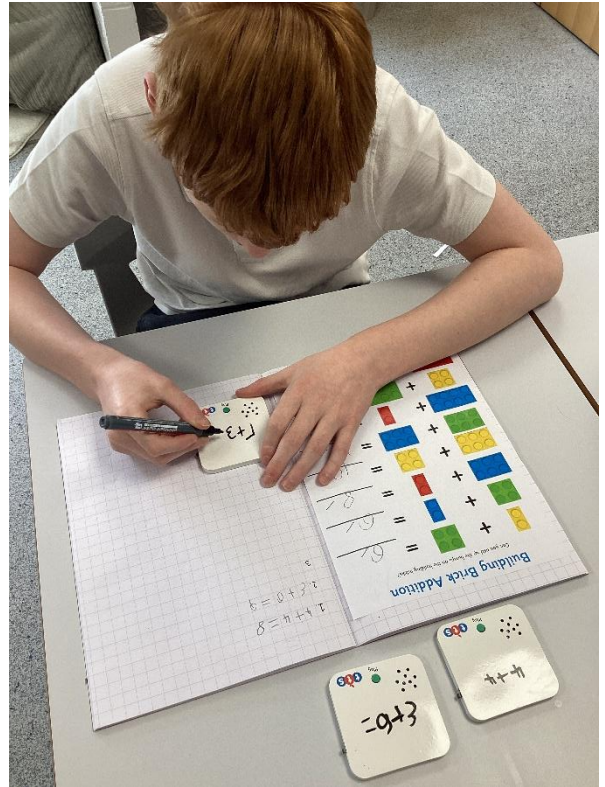


Independently using a vegetable holder to secure a cucumber while cutting it with a knife.

Subtracting one number from another to find the total left.



Adding two numbers together to find the total.



Using correct tools and movements to spread and flatten plaster onto a wall surface.



Through a work experience placement at doggy day care, completing daily tasks such as filling water bowls, preparing food, and cleaning kennels, following safety guidelines.

Our Sixth Form pupils have been developing their independence, learning new skills for in the home including cleaning and making a bed.



Independently making a bed by pulling up the sheets, smoothing out the duvet, and neatly arranging the pillows.



Using the arrow and select keys on a TV remote to navigate a menu and choose a TV programme.



Safely replacing the battery in a smoke alarm, ensuring the new battery is correctly aligned (+ and - terminals) and using the test button to check that it works.





Independently removing the vacuum canister, emptying the debris into a bin without spilling, and securely reattaching it to the vacuum.
