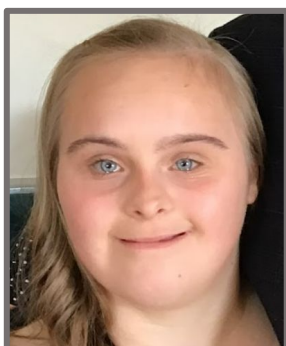
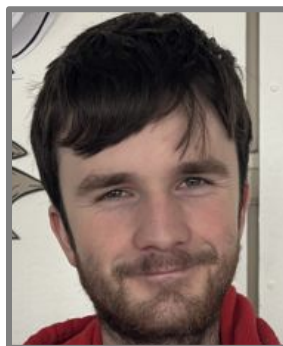


Let's Celebrate!
