This half term in class we are learning about...!

As historians, we will be looking at a history of Crewe. This will involve us looking at when and how Crewe was first developed, as well as looking at some significant people in Crewe's history.

As writers, we are exploring 'Wisp: A Story of Hope' by Zana Fraillon. We will be using this book to help us to write our own Promise Story.

As mathematicians, we will continue exploring addition and subtraction. We are currently learning lots of mental and written calculation strategies. We will move on to further explore multiplication and division, including a strong focus on our times tables.

As scientists, we will learn all about food and our bodies. We will be identifying that both animals and humans need the right amount of nutrition and where they can get it from. We will also explore the skeleton and muscles of the human body and discover how they aid movement, protection and support.
