Our learning this half term:

History or Geography	Who were The Ancient Mayans and what developments did they make? We will learn about this ancient civilization in history and look at what the area is like now.
Science	Animals including humans. This unit teaches the importance of diet, exercise and lifestyle in the way that bodies function.
English	Poetry – A Tiger in the Zoo and Historical Narrative – The Rain Player
Maths	Place Value – 4-digit numbers and Addition and Subtraction
PE	Gymnastics – Flight and Tag Rugby
RE	Christianity - How and why do Christians worship? What are the benefits for believers? How is charity a Christian value?
Computing	How can we make an interactive 360 VR image?
PSHE	Relationships – VIPs. Children will identify who their VIPs are within their families and friendship groups and how important kindness and respect are within these relationships.
Music	Guitar. This unit will be delivered by the Music for Life team for the entire Autumn term.
French	Where in the world?
DT or Art	Printing – Ancient Mayan symbols

Here are a few class routines for this term:

- PE will take place on Tuesday and Friday. Children will need warm clothes for outdoor PE lessons.
- Reading books need to be brought in daily. This year we are continuing to use the Boom Reader APP to record reading.
- All homework will be given out on Friday and is due in on Wednesdays. If your child struggles with any aspect of the homework, encourage them to tell us, then we can help them in class on the concept. All homework will be set on Google classroom and MyMaths.
- Mrs Hosker and Miss Shone will teach the class on Tuesday mornings.
