Dear Parents/Guardians,

Our prior arranged visit to Veolia before Christmas was postponed, however I am pleased to inform you that a new date has now been set. Please see a reminder of the information about the trip and the new date of Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January.

As you are aware, the year 6 children are taking part in an exciting science programme run by the University of York's Centre for Industry Education Collaboration (CIEC), which teaches primary school children about science within an industrial problem-solving context. The children have been taking part in lessons taken from the Water for Industry and Runny Liquids publications. This ends with a visit to the VEOLIA site in Ellesmere Port on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January where the children will work in groups to carry out practical activities.

The cost of this educational visit will be £8.86 per child; this includes coach fare. Although there is no obligation to contribute this money, I am afraid the visit cannot go ahead unless parents are willing to make this voluntary contribution. On application to the Head Teacher, charges may be waived or reduced under certain circumstances.

We plan to leave school by coach at 9.15am, returning by 1pm. **All children will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles please) and an additional snack.** Children should wear school uniform but as parts of the programme will be held outside (weather depending), sensible closed-toe shoes, weather appropriate clothing and a suitable waterproof coat should be worn.

For anyone who has not yet made payment, please use the SchoolMoney facility to give consent/make payment.
