Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of our learning in our topic on food and where it comes from, I have arranged for our class to visit Park Hall Farm in Oswestry on Thursday 5th March. This visit will help the children develop their understanding of how food is produced and the role farms play in providing what we eat. In the morning, the children will meet a variety of farm animals, including a Shetland pony and rabbits, and will have the opportunity to feed the goats, supporting their learning about caring for animals and where animal products come from. In the afternoon, we will take part in farm-based activities such as a tractor ride and observing the animals, alongside some fun experiences. This hands-on visit will reinforce classroom learning and give the children valuable real-life experiences linked to our topic.

The cost of this educational visit is £19.95; this includes the coach fare and workshop/activities. Although there is no obligation to contribute this money, I am afraid the visit cannot go ahead unless parents are willing to make this voluntary contribution. On application to the Head Teacher, charges may be waived or reduced under certain circumstances.

We plan to leave school by coach at 9.15am, returning by 3.00pm. All children will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles please). Children should be able to carry their own food and drink in a small bag/rucksack. No spending money required. School uniform is to be worn, and children should wear comfortable shoes; school shoes or trainers are fine and bring a waterproof coat or jacket.

Please use the SchoolMoney facility to pay and give consent for your child to go on this trip. **Payment is due by Friday 27th February.**
