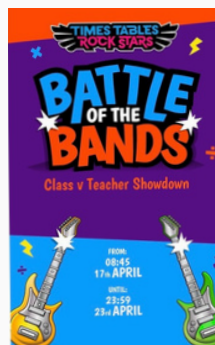
Year 6 SATs



As we move into an important time of year across school, we are continuing to support all children both academically and emotionally. For our Year 6 pupils in particular, we are preparing them carefully for their upcoming SATs in a calm and positive way, while recognising that children's achievements go far beyond academic results. To support their wellbeing, we have arranged weekly sessions with Caritas every Thursday in the lead-up to the assessments, helping children to feel confident, reassured and ready for this period.
