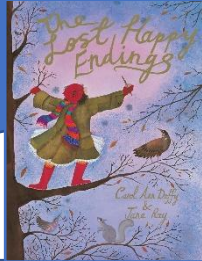
The Lost Happy Endings

Main outcome: Information text.



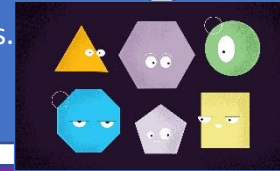

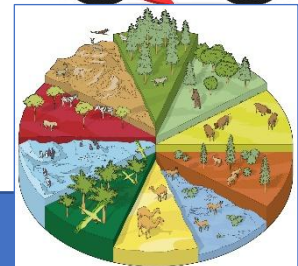
