Year 4 First Confessions – The service to celebrate the Sacrament of First Confession will take place on Wednesday 10th December at 2.00pm at St Francis of Assisi Church. A parent/carer for each child must attend. Those children who are not making their First Confession and subsequently their First Holy Communion will stay in school and should be collected at the normal time of 3.20pm.



Breakfast Club and After School Club - A reminder that you must complete a contract if you would like your child to attend breakfast or after school club, and payment must be by bank transfer or childcare vouchers. No cash payments will be accepted. If parents are late in collecting their children a £5 penalty will be issued, this is a cost incurred by school to pay for additional hours to our security team who lock up the school premises.

Flu nasal vaccine – Our school health team visited school recently to administer the flu immunisation to all children who had written consent. If you opted out of this immunisation and you have changed your mind, please contact your GP or nurse practitioner at your surgery for further advice.

Cross Country Update - We were extremely proud that three of our pupils from St Austin's were selected for the Cross Challenge which took place on Saturday 22nd November. This is a national event with both senior and junior athletes competing for places in the British team for the European Cross Country and Relay Championships. Both Liverpool Boys' and Girls' teams won the Merseyside Cross Challenge team races, and 90 children are now County Gold medallists.
