Reception class admissions September 2026 – The closing date for reception class admissions for September 2026 is Thursday 15th January. If you have not yet completed your application to school, and your online application to the Local Authority, please do so before this date for your application to be considered.

This is a recommendation following a serious case review where a school and the other children services including medical and social welfare services did not have a contact number for a family which led to serious consequences. If you are aware that you have less than 3 contacts, or if you have changed your contact information, please let our office staff know as soon as possible so that we can amend our records.
