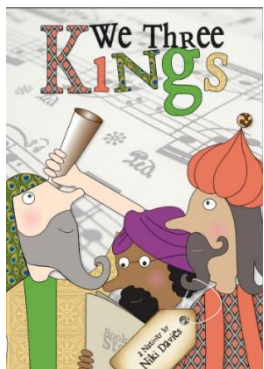
### **Choir Performance**
