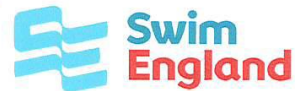

WHAT IS DIPG & ITS RESEARCH!

What is DIPG?

Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) is a rare and aggressive type of brain cancer that forms in the brain stem, specifically in an area called the pons. This part of the brain controls vital functions like breathing, heart rate, and movement.

SUPERHERO POWERS Afterschool Club

At Jam Coding, our goal is to help improve children's digital skills. Children will learn to develop the illusion of superhero powers in this micro:bit **Superhero Powers** workshop. They will learn how to program in a new coding environment and develop their coding skills to create the illusion of a range of superhero powers, including: telepathy, mind reading, transforming, ghost busting, time travelling and teleporting! Coders will learn how to run these programs on an emulator and a real Micro:Bit computer. At the end of the course, all children will receive a certificate and one team will receive a trophy!
