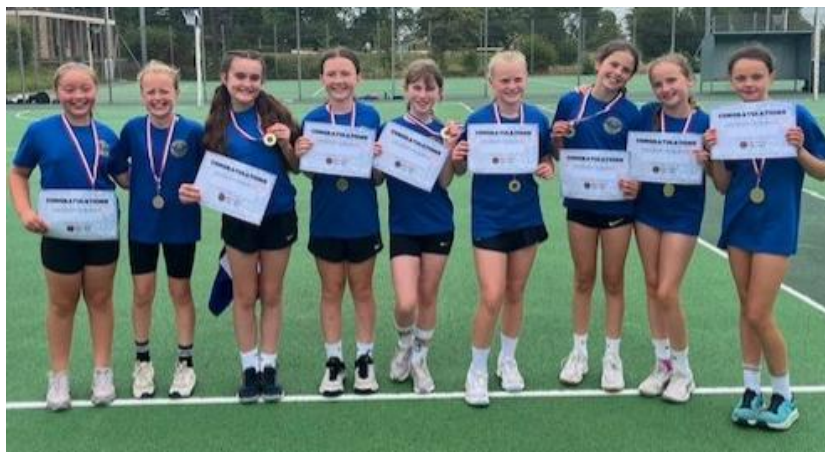

Lancashire County Council have advised us that from September we will be charging **£3.00** for a school meal for junior children unless they are in receipt of free school meals. For now, unless the Government change their minds, infants receive a free school meal – YR-Y2.

Attendance Policy from September

We would like to inform parents that in line with national expectations, our school attendance policy will be updated from September.

As part of this change, we will be implementing a fixed penalty notice (fine) system for unauthorised absences. This means that holidays taken during term time, or other absences not agreed by the school, may result in a fine being issued. Please see the letter sent out this week to share details of the updated policy before the end of term. The process to request leave and how decisions are made remains the same. Every holiday/absence request is considered on its own merit. Our aim remains to support excellent attendance, as this is vital for children's learning, wellbeing and progress. 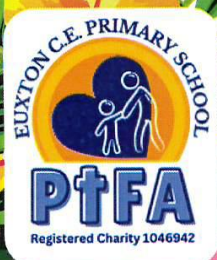
