

Year 3 Homework Activity Menu Autumn Term

To ensure children complete a range of activities they have to choose from a different column each week.

English Tasks

- **Play games to spell the CEW words for Y3** eg. scrabble, bananagrams, boggle www.ictgames.com/literacy
- **Recount writing: What exciting things have you done this week?** Don't forget to add lots of detail and sequence your ideas in order using connectives such as 'First... Then... Next... Finally...'
- **Write a book review** Title? Author? Illustrator? What was it about? Who were the main characters? Why would you recommend it to your friends?
- **Use a dictionary** Find the meaning of 5 difficult words in your reading book. Can you put the words into alphabetical order?
- **Research our class author Anthony Browne and write a fact file.** Include your opinions on his books and draw your favourite front cover.
- **Film/ voice record yourself re-telling your favourite story.** You can email this to school.

Maths Tasks

- **Play games to help with times tables and place value** eg. Sudoku, TTRS www.ictgames.com/math
- **Real-life maths** Using the digits in your phone number what calculations can you make? Use all 4 operations.
- **Column addition and subtraction** Use the column methods with up to 3 digit numbers (HTO) Remember to exchange!
- **How many ways can you make 10, 100, 1000?** Use all 4 operations.
- **Find common multiples of numbers in the 2,3,4,5 and 10x tables.** Colour in a 100 square (different colours for each table) to see where the multiples occur and cross with each other.

Life Skills

Learn your address and phone number and discuss with a grown up what you would do if you became lost.

Topic Tasks

- **Make a model Stone Age dwelling.** Use recycled packaging, outdoor materials or create on Minecraft.
- **Who was Rembrandt and why is his work popular?** Create a fact file on Rembrandt and use pencils or paints to copy the style of his work.
- **Draw a map of the UK and research one of the major cities.** What are its rivers, population, landmarks, famous people, industry?
- **Listen to 3 different classical pieces of music and appraise them.** What instruments are used? How are they similar/ different? Which is your favourite piece and why?
- **October is Black History Month.** Who was Mary Seacole?
- **Explore how magnets work.** Create a PowerPoint presentation to share your findings.
