To ensure children complete a range of activities they have to choose from a different column each week.

English Tasks

- Play games to spell the CEW words for Y3-4 eg. scrabble, bananagrams, boggle <u>www.ictgames.com/literacy</u>
- Instruction writing: How did the Ancient Egyptians mummify bodies?
 Write a series of instructions to show the process of mummification.
- Read different versions of traditional fairy stories eg. Revolting Rhymes, Mixed Up Fairy Tales.
- Sequence 10 words in alphabetical order Choose tricky words from your reading book and write them in alphabetical order. Challenge yourself to words beginning with the same letter!
- Research our class author Enid Blyton and write a fact file. Include your opinions on her books and draw your favourite front cover.
- How is direct speech punctuated? Find examples in your reading book, then write out a short conversation you have had with someone.

Maths Tasks

- Play games to help with times tables and place value eg. Sudoku, TTRS www.ictgames.com/maths
- Related Facts Learn your 3x, 4x and 8x tables and their related division facts. eg 4x3=12, 3x4=12, 12÷4=3, 12÷3=4
- Measure in mm, cm and m How tall is everyone in your family? What is the perimeter of your garden? Can you convert your measurements into mm?
- Raman Numerals Learn roman numerals for numbers to 12, and key numbers such as 50, 100, 500, 1000 etc Where do we use roman numerals?
- Column addition and subtraction
 Continue working on these standard methods including exchange.

Life Skills

Create a poster explaining how to stay safe around water, railway lines, and how to cross roads safely.

Topic Tasks

- Learn about Louis Braille. Create a fact file on his life, and explore the braille alphabet.
- Investigate food groups and what is needed for a balanced diet.

 Create an Eatwell Plate showing the proportions of carbohydrates, proteins, fruit/veg, fats and dairy.
- Create a leaflet advertising life in Cheshire (East and West) Include information on the county capital, main industries, rivers, transport systems, historical places etc.
