- Geography is about people and places.
- Human features – houses, roads, bridges – have been built by people.
- Physical features – seas, mountains, rivers – are natural.
- Longsight is mostly human geography.
- People are connected to places in different ways.



- We can show a route on a map and use symbols to show things on our route.
- We can describe a journey using left, right, straight, near or far.

- We live in Longsight, Manchester.
- Manchester is a city in the country England.
- The United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries – England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales.



- Maps can show us where things are in Longsight, how to get from one place to another.
- Old maps can show us what Longsight was like 100 years ago.
- Many buildings have changed and trams ran on the main roads.
- 100 years ago there were shops and houses and there still are today.
- Some houses are the same.

- Longsight has changed in the past 100 years.

- Migration is when people move to an area.
- There are more mosques and different shops because different people live in Longsight.
