

Where We Live



In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of number and place value of numbers to 10. We will also begin to learn about addition and subtraction.

In English, we will be reading 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. The children will develop their sentence writing by composing a sentence orally before writing it, sequencing events and sentences, and re-reading what they have written to check it makes sense. We will also begin to learn and use capital letters, finger spaces, and full stops.

In Science, children will identify and name different materials and their properties.

In RE, children will understand what it means to belong to a faith community and identify sacred places of worship in their local area.

In History, the children will learn about the history of our school and our area (Longsight) and how it has changed over time. We will describe similarities and differences between now and then.

In PSHE, we will start to understand how we change and grow, both physically and emotionally. Children will learn about their own and others' bodies, gender stereotypes and different families. They will also learn about respecting their own and others bodies, keeping their bodies safe and sharing their feelings.

In Art children will explore the work of L.S Lowry and create Lowry inspired pictures of their local area.

In Geography, the children will understand that we live in the UK, in a country called England. We will learn that we live in a city called Manchester and Longsight is the town we live in. They will identify key human and physical features around our local area and use these to create simple maps.

In Music, children will listen to and appraise a piece of music. They will play games to develop their understanding of pulse, rhythm and pitch as well as working towards performing a piece of music.
