Latitude - the distance of a place from the Equator measured in degrees

Tropic of Cancer - a line of latitude 23.5 degrees North of the Equator

Tropic of Capricorn - A line of latitude 23.5 degrees South of the Equator

Tropical - to do with the hot regions between the tropic of Cancer and Capricorn

North Hemisphere - the Northern half of the Earth

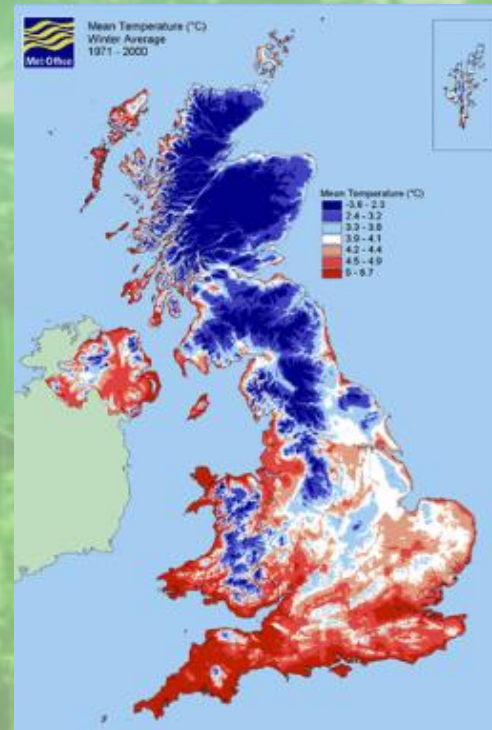
Southern Hemisphere - the Southern half of the Earth

Meteorological - to do with the study of weather conditions and climate

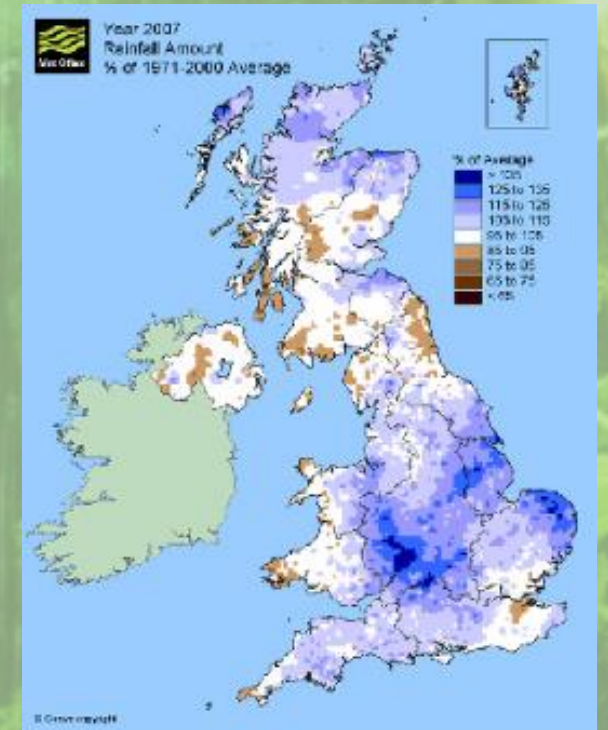
Biome - an area classified by its unique climate, animal and plant life.
