

Wonderful Weather



In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of number and place value of numbers to 40. We will begin to learn some simple multiplication and division.

In Geography, we will be learning about the four seasons and what they look like in the UK. We will be learning about similarities and differences in weather across the seasons and what extreme weather can look like.



In English, we will be reading 'Grandpa's Gift' by Fiona Lumbers. The children will develop their sentence writing by composing a sentence orally before writing it, sequencing events and sentences, and re-reading what they have written to check it makes sense. We will also be focusing on using question marks and pre-fixes.

In Art we will be learning about the artist Kandinsky. We will begin to develop an understanding of primary colour, how these colours can be mixed and experimenting with different tools.



In Science, we will be learning about the four seasons. We will also be making weather observations and using scientific equipment to measure different types of weather.

In RE we will explore how and why we celebrate special and sacred times.

We will look at different religions and learn about special religious celebrations.

In PSHE we will be learning about healthy mental health and emotions.

We will also learn all about having a healthy lifestyle. This will include hand washing, healthy teeth, and healthy eating.

In Music we will continue to practice our music skills, including volume, tempo, and expression.

We will develop our performance skills and build our confidence in a group.
