



In Maths, children will be learning about multiplication of 2s, 5s and 10s. Exploring what multiplication means, what it looks like and finding patterns.

In Music, children will listen to and appraise various rock music, and build on their knowledge and understanding of the different aspects of

In Geography, children will create their own treasure maps using keys. They will follow maps using compass points and landmarks and use aerial photographs to recognise human and physical features.

In Art, children will study and draw portraits using different media and elements such as line, shape and colour.

In Computing, children will be learning to use spreadsheets to add images, solve puzzles, and create tables and graphs.

In English, children will write journey stories based on The Story of Grandad's Camper.

In Science, children will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

They can find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. They will use their knowledge of materials to design and build a pirate ship.
