

Spring 2 - What is a river?

Geography

Pupils will be finding out about what rivers are by investigating the following questions:

How does the course of the River Axe change from source to mouth?
How does my local river change from source to mouth?

Why are river estuaries such important places for wildlife?

Why are rivers such an important part of the water cycle?

Why is river flooding such a problem in Bangladesh?

Maths

Pupils will be studying mixed number fractions, improper fractions and how to convert between the two. Also learning about the measurement of time and decimals.

ICT

The children will use concept mapping tools to continue to learn about using technology safely and responsibly.

PSHE

Pupils will be studying different types of relationships, gender roles and what changes happen to our bodies as we grow.

Science

We will be investigating states of matter and experimenting with the processes by which they change.

English

Children will learn about the book *Wisp* by Zana Fraillon and Grahame Baker Smith. They will learn to write a first person recount.

RE

Children will continue to learn about Jesus and identify why Easter is the most important time of the year for Christians.

PE

Children will be working in Gymnastics, by focusing on 5 different balances and transitioning to build a sequence.

Music

Pupils will sing songs and sing in unison and parts for performance.

ART

We will be looking at MC Escher and practicing ways to create different shading and texture with pencils.
