In Maths, we will continue to develop our understanding of place value using numbers to up to 100. We will then use those numbers in addition and subtraction problems. Finally, the children will explore money, mass and capacity.

In English, we will learn about the difference between fiction and non-fiction texts, focusing on non-fiction texts. We will learn the story of 'Goldilocks and just the One Bear' to help us write a non-chronological report about bears.

In Science, we will be learning about different types of plants and trees we can find in our local area. We will also continue to observe changes over time to the world around us.

In RE we will be learning about what makes some places sacred. The children will explore the similarities and differences between how faiths treat sacred places.

In History, we will be learning about different explorers from the past and present. We will discuss the discoveries they made and the expeditions they carried out.

In PSHRE, we will be developing our British Values by looking at our class rules, we will be looking at where our money comes from, and we will be learning about the environment.

In Art, we will be exploring the role that clay plays in our lives. We will experiment with adding patterns to clay, before moving on to make our very own painted pinch pots.

In Music we will be learning a new song all about imagination. We will be listening and appraising the music, singing the words and taking turns and finally performing it!
