

# Year 2 Summer 2: Where does our food come from?

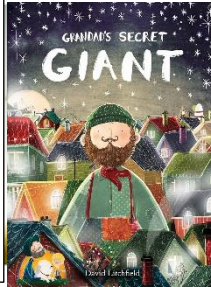


## Maths

Our focus this term is on shape, space and measure. We will learn how to read scales and the units used to measure length, mass, temperature and time. It would help with our learning if we could practice telling the time while we are at home.

## English

We are reading Grandad's Secret Giant this term. We will describe characters and setting while practising our grammar and punctuation skills and finally write our own stories.



## Geography

In Geography, we will continue learning about where our food comes from. We will visit a dairy farm to see how milk is produced and how it is transported in many different forms.

We will find out about how much of our food is produced in other countries and how it gets to us.

## Computing

In Computing, we are learning how computer programs work and designing our own program.

## PSHE

This term we will focus on living in the wider world. We will be thinking about the question:

What groups and communities am I a part of?

## PE

We will develop our athletic skills and team game abilities.

## Music

We will explore our feelings through music this term and look at how different tempos can reflect feelings.

## RE

In RE lessons we will learn about sacred texts and their importance to different faiths.

## DT

In DT we will create moving pictures based on traditional tales using different wheels, sliders and levers.

## Science

This term, children will learn what plants need to stay healthy. They will have the opportunity to carry out their own investigations into what plants need to grow well. Children will also closely observe the inside of a seed and learn about the life cycle of a plant. They will also learn how plants look when they don't get the things they need.
