Why did the Romans organise gladiatorial games?

The Romans in Britain
(including Manchester)

English

Pupils will be revising features of grammar from Year 3, reading a wide variety of texts and learning about Katherine Johnson and the space race to write a factfile.

RE

Pupils will be exploring different reasons why Jesus is considered an inspiring figure by Christians.

Science

Pupils will be investigating how sounds are made and exploring differences in pitch, volume and how sounds change over a distance.

Maths

Pupils will practice counting in 10s, 25s, 50s and 100s and will investigate place value up to four digit numbers.

PSHRE

We will be finding out about British Values including values we share, how are our Prime Minister and Government voted in and what our rights and responsibilities are.

PE

Children will be improving Rolling & travelling low in Gymnastics and learning how to stay safe when entering the swimming pool.

Music

Children will create simple melodic phrases and patterns to compose a short tune.

Computing

Pupils will be using search technologies to find information and will select suitable software to create music.

Pupils in drawing will be practising perspective, focusing on a Roman street.
