Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to express my sincere gratitude to everyone who took the time to complete our recent survey. As a school, we pride ourselves on being a community that listens, and your feedback provides us with the insight we need to ensure your children continue to thrive.

We are incredibly heartened by the overwhelmingly positive responses. In particular, it was wonderful to see that so many of you value our commitment to **multiculturalism and mutual respect** as well as wanting **the best for our pupils**. Our goal has always been to create an environment where every child feels seen and every faith is respected, and your comments suggest we are achieving this together.

Below is a summary of what you feel we are doing well and the concrete steps we are taking to improve.

"A safe, inclusive, and high-achieving community."

We are proud to share the results of our 2026 Parent Survey. With **98% of parents recommending our school**, it is clear that our commitment to safety, multicultural respect, and high academic standards is resonating with our families.

📊 The Headline Figures

- 98% Recommendation Rate: Almost every parent would recommend us to another family.
- 97% Safety Rating: A massive majority of parents agree their child feels safe here.
- 91% Engagement: Parents feel our staff are engaging and support their child's wider development.
- 87% Happiness/13% neutral: The vast majority of our students are happy coming to school every day.

🌟 What We Are Doing Well

Your feedback showed that our core values are being felt across the community:

- **Strong Ethos:** Our values (Peace, Friendship, Love and Respect, Wisdom, Justice and Thankfulness) are making a real impact, with 87% of parents seeing a positive effect on their child's behaviour.
- **Inclusion & Respect:** Parents overwhelmingly praised our commitment to multiculturalism. You noted that we "show all religions and races are the same" and that children are taught to respect everyone.
- **Safety & Wellbeing:** Over 97% of you feel your children are safe and cared for. One parent noted: *"The school is excellent, highly efficient, and dedicated to children's education."*
- **High Expectations:** 87% of you agreed for our "high expectations yet kind approach," with parents appreciating our focus on attendance and discipline.
- **Supportive Staff:** Our team, led by Mr. Uddin, was described as "engaging," "approachable," and "dedicated to children's progress."

✂ What We Are Improving (You Said, We Did)

We have listened to your suggestions for growth and are taking the following actions:

1. Communication & Academic Visibility

- **You Said:** You want to be more involved in what your children are learning and see more physical homework.
- **We Did:** We are re-sharing our **Termly Knowledge organisers and Topic Webs** (visit the [website](#) or Class Dojo) for every year group and looking at **paper-based homework sheets** to bridge the gap between school and home - the majority of our homework is online, especially with older pupils as we want them prepared for high school.

2. Traffic & Site Safety

- **You Said:** Traffic and parking at the school gates are a significant safety hazard.
- **We Did:** We are continuing to work with the local council to request **traffic calming measures** and stricter parking enforcement. We have introduced our **Junior PCSOs** to help monitor and raise profile of child safety around school traffic.

3. Student Voice & Bullying

- **You Said:** You want more support for children's confidence and for students to be heard during conflicts.
- **We Did:** Our "suggestion boxes" are picked up by **Digital Ambassadors who follow up incidents and feedback** which are then actioned. This ensures pupils are wholly involved. Our **Behaviour Policy** and approach is based on restorative practice where all pupils' voices are heard before decisions are made about consequences and actions..

4. Environment & Facilities

- **You Said:** Some children are concerned about toilet hygiene and playground organisation.
- **We Did:** We have initiated an **enhanced daily cleaning audit** for all pupil toilets and reviewing playtimes to minimise incidents

5. Supporting Every Learner

- **You Said:** You want more support for **middle attainers** to reach the next level and more after-school clubs.
- **We Did:** Teachers are specifically reviewing learning strategies and interventions continually for our middle-attaining students. We are also continually working to **expand our After-School Club timetable** with more to be added next term.

Together, we are building a school where every child is respected, every parent is heard, and every student is safe to learn. Where every child can **'Love To Learn, Learn To Do Well and Live Well Together'**.
