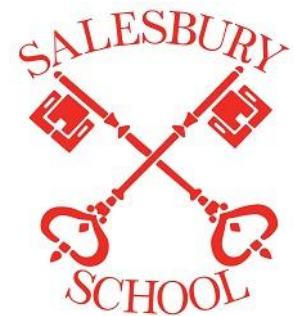
Learning Focus: Geography (Team GB)

Key knowledge to learn

- 1** Name, locate and identify the **four countries** and **capital cities** of the UK and the **surrounding seas**.
Countries – England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland
Capital Cities – London, Cardiff, Edinburgh, Belfast
Seas – North Sea, Irish Sea, English Channel, North Atlantic Ocean, Celtic Sea.
- 2** Identify significant **landmarks**
Scotland – Edinburgh Castle, Ben Nevis, Loch Ness
England – Hadrian’s Wall, The Angel of the North, Blackpool Tower, Stonehenge, White Cliffs of Dover, Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament
Wales – Snowden, Cardiff Castle, Pontcysylite Aqueduct
Northern Ireland – The Giant’s Causeway, Titanic Belfast, Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge
- 3** Identify human and physical features, such as:
Humans features – Clitheroe Castle, Blackpool Tower
Physical features – Pendle Hill, Longridge Fell
- 4** To use a world map, atlas and globe to locate the UK and its countries, (England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland).
- 5** Name and locate the world’s **7 continents**, (Asia, Africa, North & South America, Antarctica, Europe, Australia) and **5 oceans**, (Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Artic & Southern, also known as Antarctic)
- 6** Why Fairtrade foods are a good choice.

Vocabulary

Continent	A large area of land.
Ocean	A large continuous area of sea.
Human feature	Created and made by humans.
Physical feature	Created by nature and not humans.
Landmark	An object/feature of a landscape or town.
Fairtrade	A fair price is paid to those that produce the food in developed countries.
