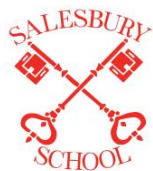
Notes for parents and carers

Reading – daily task

Aim for at least 5 minutes per day – don't forget to put this in your reading diary and have your **Game Board signed**. Try to read aloud- this will improve fluency and understanding.

Please prioritise reading with your child.



Spellings & Key words – weekly task

Use Spelling Shed to practise the spellings and their pattern, in the form of a game.

Complete the weekly sheet sent home on a Friday, (paper copy).

Key words taught every week in Phonics will be on your child's class page on the school website.

Real & Alien Words - Spot the main grapheme in each word, then sound it out and finally blend the sounds to read each word.



Maths - weekly task

- Mission in Maths Grid – focus on the tasks that your child is not yet fluent in/confident with.

(If your child is able to recall all number bonds to 10 fluently, focus on number bonds to 20).

Please prioritise this with your child.



Creative Task – Easter bonnet/crown using natural/recycled items. Lots of ideas on Pinterest. A prize will be given per class for the best bonnet/crown.

Please send in your child's creation on Tuesday 31st March.
