Monday and Friday – PE

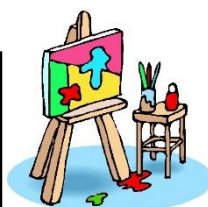
Every day- We will access learning outdoors every day. Please can I ask for your child to bring in a pair of wellies that we can keep in school. Thank you!
