How do some people talk to God?

The children will learn about different reasons for prayer as well as how some people prepare for it. The children will also explore different prayer rituals and be able to explain why prayer is important to some people.

PE

Athletics – Children will look at fundamental movement skills and how these can be applied to track and field events.
