






PE days for this half term are Tuesday and Thursday.


Homework is given on a Thursday, and is due for the next Thursday. Spellings will be tested on Thursday. Reading books will be changed on a Thursday.

Maths

Geography






In history, we will be looking at maps. We will consider how Accrington has changed from Anglo Saxon times until now.

P.S.H.E.
