Here are some activities for you to complete at home, all about rainforests and classification. Please choose one to complete each week and hand in. You must complete at least 6 by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March.

Research an animal that lives in a rainforest. Create a fact file about this animal.	Research the foods that grow and are eaten in the rainforest. What dishes can you make using them?	Write a diary entry as though you are lost in the rainforest. What can you see, hear, smell, feel?
Create a Venn diagram of all the animals that live in the rainforest, which ones will intersect?		What food chains are there in the rainforest? Can you research a food web?
What maths facts can you find out about the Amazon rainforest?	Using collage materials, create a piece of artwork that represents the rainforest. Can you make a rainforest in a box/jar?	Use scratch online to create a rainforest animation or game.
