Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome back. We hope you had a lovely, restful half term. Here is an idea of what we will be learning in Year 3 and 4 in our new topics over the next 7 weeks. Our Lens this half term is: **'Spirituality'**. Our Big Question this half term is: **'Where is belonging?'**, where we will look at **'How did the achievements of the ancient Maya impact their society and beyond?'** in history and **'Sound'** in science.

What will we be learning?

We have lots of great learning opportunities coming up this half-term:

Maths:



- Geometry
- Decimals
- Time
- Statistics

English: In classes Year 3 and Year 3/4, children will be completing work based on the book 'Dear Earth' Isabel Otter and in Year 4, they will be studying the book 'The Invisible' by Oliver Jeffers.



History: We will be exploring what society was like for the Ancient Maya along with their achievements. Within our lessons, we will explore how and why they settled in the rainforest, what they believed and understand how their cities worked.

RE: We will explore the question: How is history and religion entwined? Children will explore religious roots within Warwickshire, looking at texts, buildings and art. They will also look at whether Coventry is a city of peace and reconciliation.



DT: This half term we will be looking at Textiles. We In our lessons, we will explore different types of fastenings, leading us to make our ow book covers with a fastening of our choice.

Science: This half term, we will be looking at Sound. We will explore how sounds are made, how they reach our ears and how we can change sounds.



PE: Children will be doing Golf with Mr Whittle on a Monday – for all classes. With class teachers, children will be looking at Gymnastics. Remember children are to come to school in PE kit on PE days.

Computing: We will explore online relationships and email as well as effective searching and logos.





Music: Year 3 and 4 will be singing each Monday morning. They will also begin to look at composing music.
