Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome back for the second part of our Autumn Term; here is an idea of what we will be learning in Year 1 and 2 in our new topic: '**Why is the World Wonderful? - Oceans**'

What will we be learning?

We have lots of fun learning coming up this half-term.



Maths:

- Addition and Subtraction
- Shape

Science: We will be investigating materials and their properties. We will use this information to sort objects into groups.



English: We will be looking at non-chronological texts and researching ocean animals. We will use this information to write texts about a chosen animal. We will be learning and performing poems as well as writing our own ocean poems.

Geography: We will identify the continents and the oceans of the world. We will look at what makes the oceans wonderful and what we need to do to protect them.



RE: We will be focusing on the theme Incarnation and exploring why Christmas matters to Christians. We will also be performing the Nativity to retell the story of the birth of Jesus.

ART: We will be creating 3D art from clay. We will be looking at sea creatures and parts of the creatures and representing what we see in the form of clay sculptures.



PE: Year 1/2MB PE days will be Tuesday and Thursday.

Year 1/2CH PE days will be Monday and Thursday

Year 2 PE days will be Monday and Friday.

We will be working on Team Building activities and Invasion Games.



Computing: We will be looking at the technology and IT around us and developing our touch-typing skills.



Music: We will be using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. We will be listening to a variety of pop and classical music.
