Knowledge Organisers

Knowledge organisers are a tool which summarise key facts and essential knowledge that we teach in school, linked to the National Curriculum. Every time your child starts a new a new unit of work, this will be associated with a knowledge organiser. This is essentially a “fact sheet” for the topic.

You can support your child by discussing the information on the knowledge organisers with your son or daughter and quizzing them on what they know.
