

Year 2 overview Spring Term 2026

English

We will be reading 'The Owl who was afraid of the Dark' and looking at different sentence types including question and exclamation sentences. In Sp2 we will be writing diaries based on our history topic 'The Great Fire of London.'



Maths

In Power Maths we will be exploring multiplication and division and starting to learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will then be moving onto recognising and using money, followed by work on standard units of measurement.



Science

In Science we will be focusing on biology. We will learn about what animals and humans need in order to survive. In Spr2 we will look at food chains and how animals are linked in terms of their survival.

History

We will be looking at The Great Fire of London 1666. We will look at the cause and effect of the fire, learn about key figures in the fire including Thomas Fariner and Samuel Pepys. The children will look at a range of primary and secondary sources to gain historical insight.



Geography

We will be looking at the UK and identifying the 4 capital cities. We will complete fieldwork on our residential in Spring 1. Following this we will compare the localities of Ellesmere Port and the village of Burwardsley.


Art

We will be looking at structures, specifically houses and linking this to the timber frame buildings from the time of the Great Fire of London.



RE

We will look at the question 'Why is the bible important to Christians?' We will be learning about different bible stories and how Christians talk to God through prayer.



PSHE

We will be looking at caring and responsibility in Sp1 and in Spr2 focusing on friendships.



Music

In music we are continuing to look at how to use our voices and exploring pitch and volume.

In PE we will be receiving football sessions from Liverpool FC this term every Tuesday. Kit needs to be worn every Tuesday and Friday.



Computing

We will be learning about algorithms and using block coding.
