At William Stockton, we value writing and encourage children to express themselves creatively.

In Nursery, children engage in mark making, learning how shapes convey meaning. In Reception, they apply phonics to write words and explore texts through pictures and phrases.

Year 1 writers begin using adjectives and joining sentences with “and.” By Year 2, they enhance their writing with “because.”

In Year 3, children learn prepositions to describe locations. Year 4 focuses on sentence structure, using fronted adverbials.

By Year 5, students incorporate relative clauses, and in Year 6, they master complex punctuation, including brackets, dashes, semi-colons, and colons.

We are proud of our students’ writing journeys! Every child is a writer here!

We are very excited to be putting the final preparations in for our Christmas performances next week! You are in for an absolutely wonderful time. The children have been practising so hard, and we are so proud of the effort they are putting in. Their enthusiasm and dedication truly shine through in every rehearsal.
