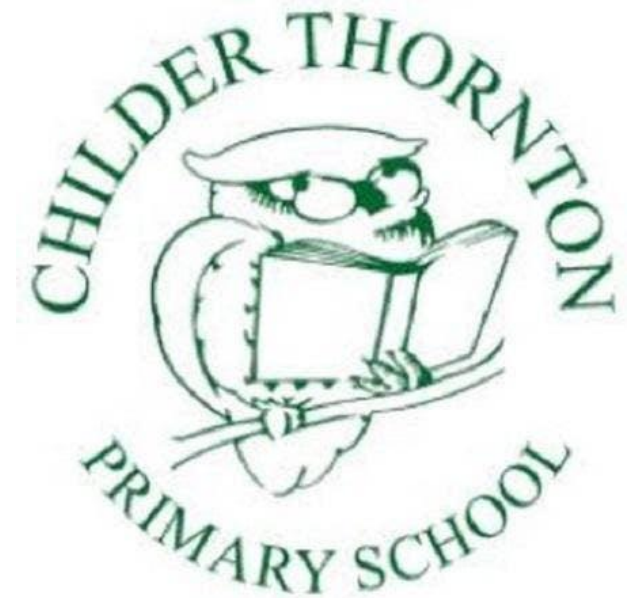
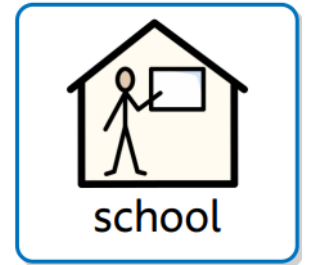
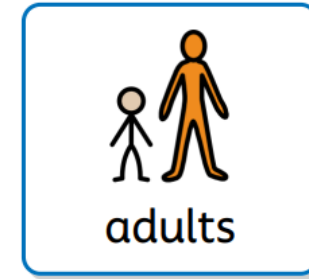


Welcome to Maple Class!

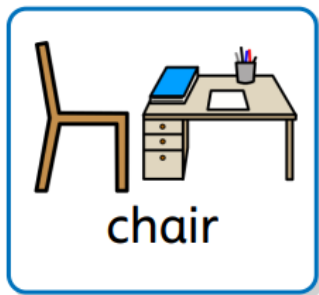

You will have a tray to keep your bookbag and any drawings or letters.

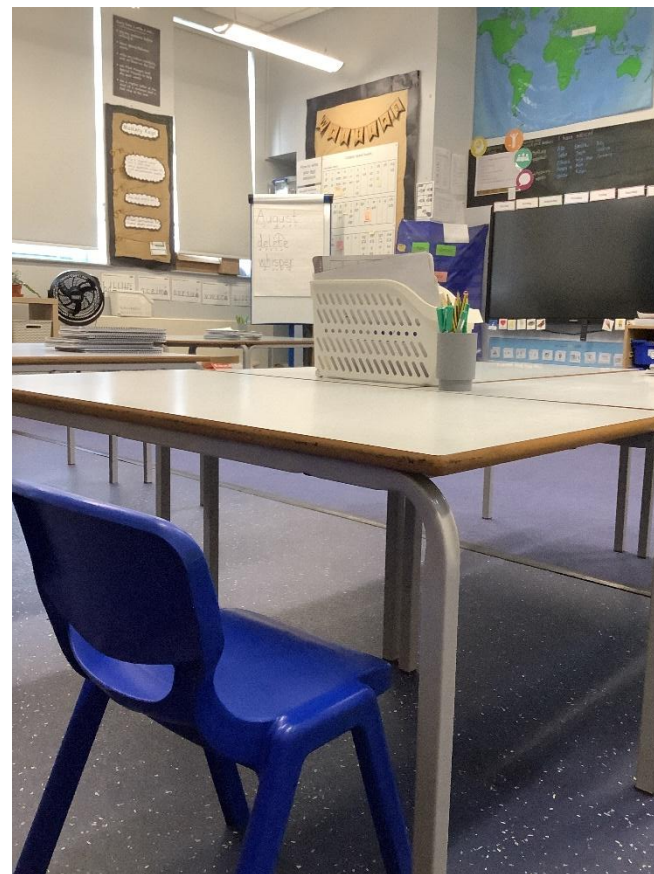

reading area

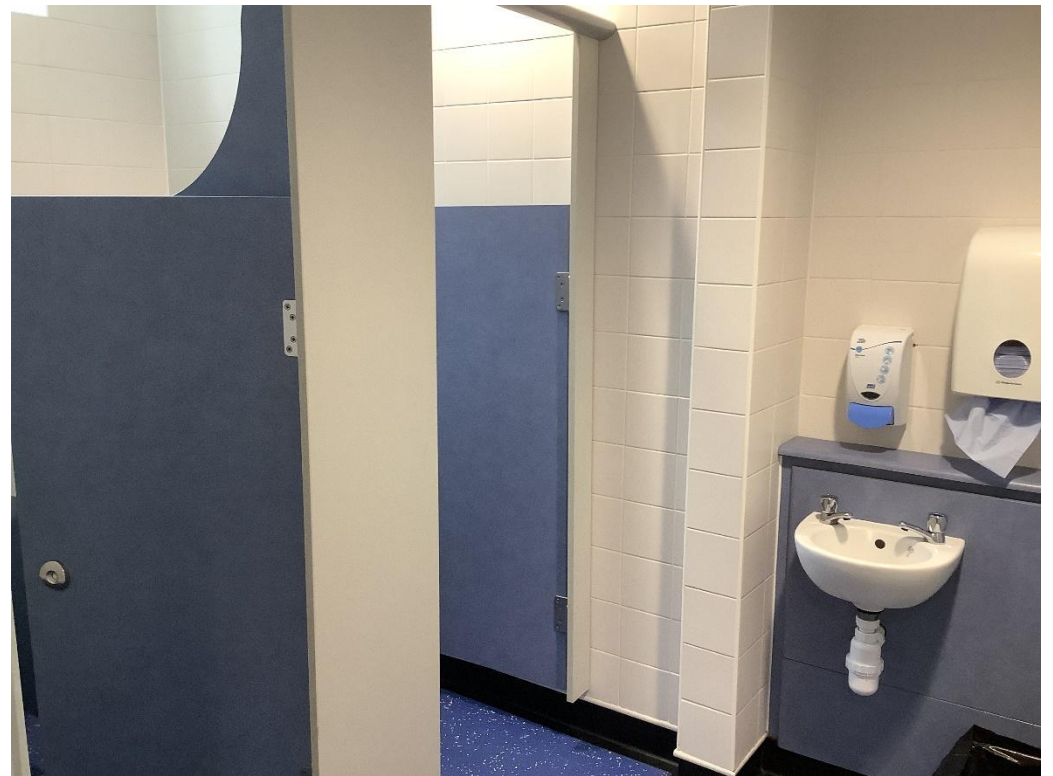

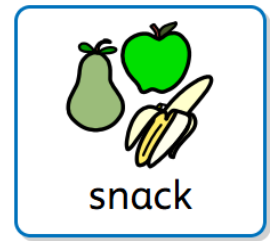


We have our own toilet inside our classroom as well as two toilets we share with Year Two in the corridor.

At lunchtime, you will still eat our lunch in the hall just like you do now and then you can go out to play in the playground.

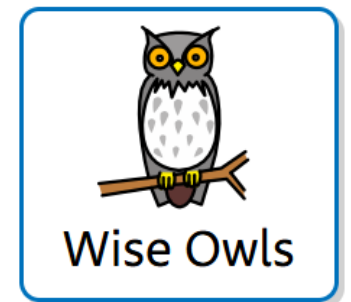




At home time, you will
