





#### Length and Perimeter




#### **Length and Perimeter**

Length is the measurement of an object from end to end.

**Perimeter** is the measurement of the distance around a 2D shape. In other words, the length of the outline of the shape.

We can work out the perimeter of a shape by adding together the length of all its sides. Let's work out the perimeter of this garden:



**Perimeter** = 
$$2 + 1 + 1 + 3 + 3 + 4$$


