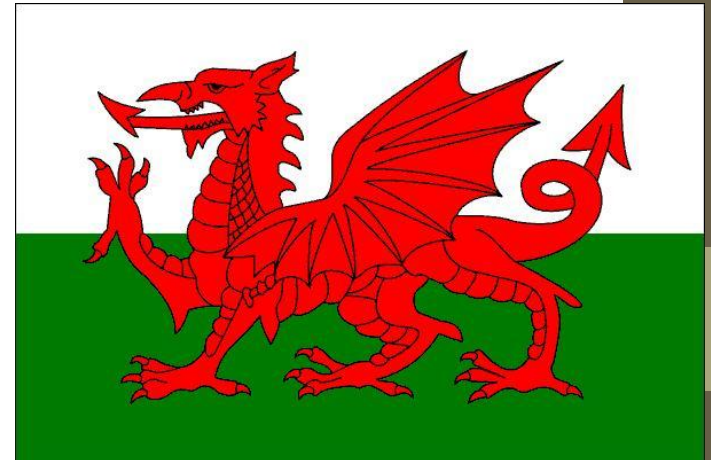

Day 1

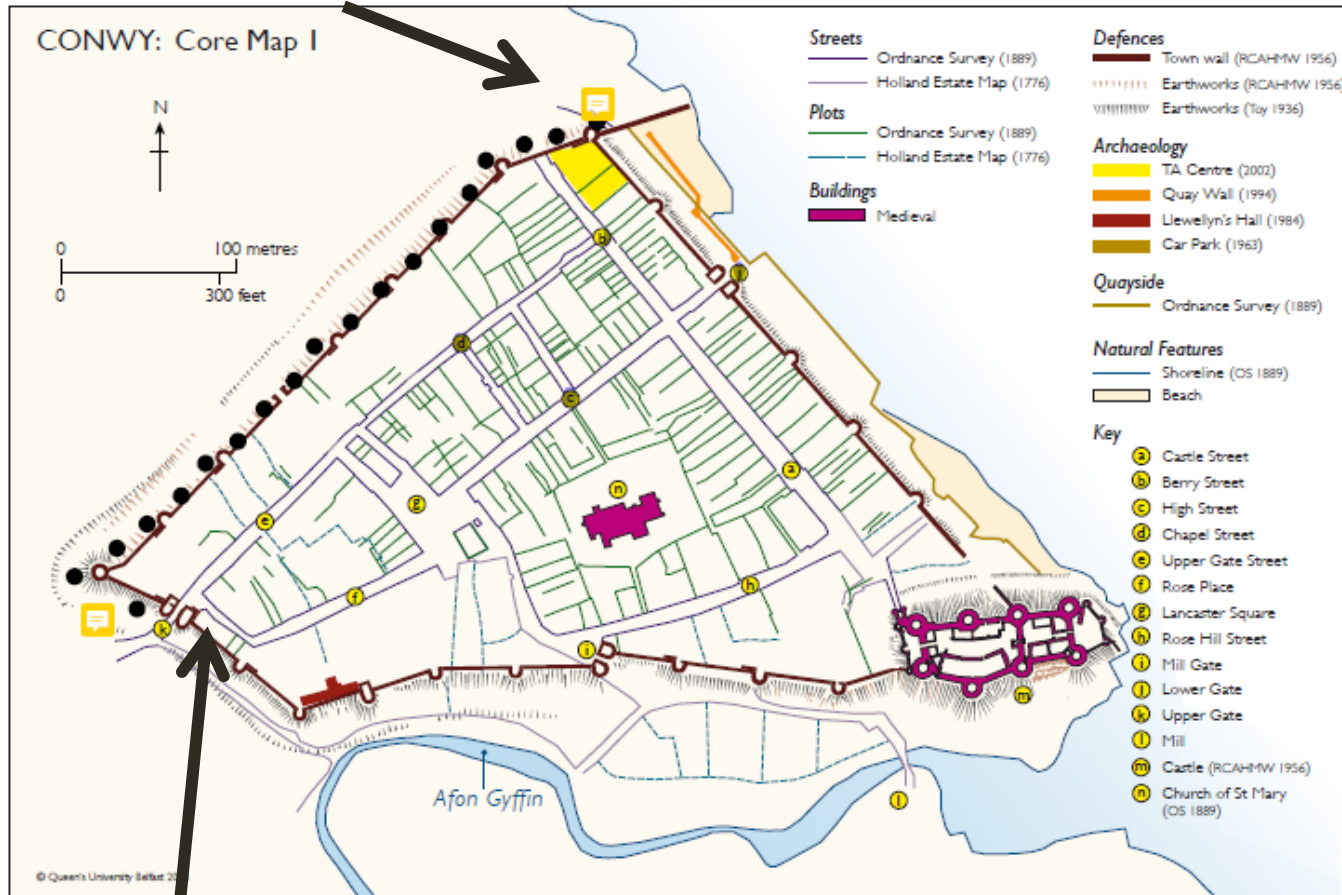
- Arrive at school by 8.10am at the latest, leave cases outside by the office, bring small backpacks into the classroom for us to check and put in sketchbooks & lunches from school.
- Enter through front to register, leaving school at 8.30am prompt.
- Arrive at Conwy and visit Conwy castle 10.30am
- Tour around the castle.
- 12.00 noon walk along the castle walls then onto the sea front to see the smallest house

Exit here, short walk down the street under the tunnel onto the seafront by the Smallest House.



Join castle walls here at Upper Gate Street as this is the first break in the castle walls and the last.



Day 1



- Lunch outside the Smallest House – some benches with a lovely sea view, if weather is bad we have a space reserved with the local pub next door.
- Each child will visit the Smallest House
- Time for castle sketches
- Walk back to Conwy Castle using the town route.
- Meet the coach at 1.30 for a short coach journey to the Llandudno Hostel
- Rules, safety, fire drills & room allocation, drop off bags
- Walk to the seafront, sandcastle building and games on the beach (*timing subject to the tide*)
- Return to hostel for tea at 5pm.

Communal sitting room, no other guests as the hostel is exclusive to our school on these dates. Double front doors and no access/exit for children.



Breakfast and evening meals in the dining room. Day 1 – tea and dessert.
Day 2 – Cooked breakfast, toast and cereals. Unlimited toast and cereal.
Day 2 – Bap, crisps, chocolate bar, fruit & drink.
Hot chocolate making facilities.



Bunk beds in all rooms.

No bedrooms on the ground floor. Floor 1 = boys and staff

Floor 2 = girls and staff, toilets and bathrooms on each floor.



Evening Activities

Evening meal 5.00pm

Home cooked meal in the hostel

Children will vote and choose the main dish and salad and a selection of vegetables will be available.

A dessert of ice cream for afterwards.

Juice, water and milk all available.

Any dietary requirements/allergies, school should have this information already but anything that has changed needs to be on the Form 'C'.

After tea we will have a walk along the pier and around the town centre to find some of the Alice in Wonderland sculptures.

Diary writing, story time and hot chocolate & biscuits before bed at 7.30pm prompt!

- Please give anti-sickness medication to your child before you arrive at school, let us know the dosage and next requirements – fill form in, in advance.
